KNOW GOD: KNOW - GROW - GO!

Worship & Witness Looking Back, 2023-24

Life-giving Worship Services



KNOW GOD: We gather to worship God in a life-giving worship service, and learn to apply His Word to our lives. We long to witness the reality of His Kingdom among us, through His divine presence, healing and gifts of the Holy Spirit in use.



Last year we saw:

- Sunday Service attendance grow: We have 113 people regularly attending (at least once per month), with many more new people who are either new or attend less often.
- LCC Partners: 52 adults are partners, and we saw 8 new people become partners this year.
- The Next Steps Journey course continues to be successful
 in seeking to integrate new people into the life of the church.
 It helps them to "discover family and find their fit" by
 being welcomed into Partnership, joining a Life Group, and
 serving as part of a team.
- Kingdom Transformation: We document any response to salvation & the message. These are followed-up weekly. We are hearing testimonies of healing, and God's provision in people's lives, as well as seeing the release of spiritual gifts. There is a growing sense of God's manifested presence in our midst as we gather to worship.
- 2 baptism services (including one on Easter Sunday), and
 8 people went public with their faith and got baptised!
- Encounter Nights & Prayer & Fasting weeks continue to be significant amongst us as we lean into the Lord.

GROW TOGETHER: KNOW - GROW - GO!

Discipleship & Development Looking Back, 2023-24



<u>GROW</u> TOGETHER: We gather together in pairs/ small groups (*Life Groups*) to grow in our relationship with Jesus, through discipleship. It includes the development and release of leaders for the Church, and teams for planting expressions.

Last year we saw:

- **Life Groups:** These run termly, with groups catering for men, women, prayer, Bible Study and online groups too (to cater for those who cannot meet in-person e.g. due to child-care challenges).
- **Elevate,** (our youth ministry for school years 6+.on a Friday night), relaunched using the Main Hall, to make space for growth using a wider range of equipment.
- **Sunday Stars** (school years reception to 5) continues to grow on a Sunday. We are now running 4 Sundays per month, as the team grows.
- The Completion of LD #1 (Leadership Development cohort 1), and the launch of LD #2 (2nd cohort). LD #2 consists of 8 men and women who are currently on a 4 month course with Ps. Dave and Leanne, being trained and equipped in various aspects of leadership. This relational based course involves group sessions together, small group meals and 1:1 sessions, all designed to equip and help participants to reflect and grow on their unique leadership journeys.

GO! MAKE A DIFFERENCE: Ministry & Mission KNOW - GROW - GO! Looking Back, 2023-24

MINISTRY: Last year we saw:

 Serving teams build: 52 different people actively serve on one or more teams. We intentionally promote and celebrate multi-generational serving teams of adults and children! We have now adopted a regular serving pattern for all Sunday team rotas, so that people know when they are serving on a particular team. This helps those heroes who serve on multiple teams or more than once per month.

 Kids' Take-over Services: We regularly have family services, but for the first time we had 2 Kids' Take-over services which saw children and young people lead and participate across all teams, including speaking. They did so well!

 Our annual volunteer's Christmas meal take place to celebrate and thank all our serving team heroes.

 We also trialled our first ever New Year's Eve Celebration (with Watch Night Service), which saw so many families attend. Food from around the world was enjoyed, fun was had with a fantastic quiz, and we entered the New Year worshipping Jesus! Feedback from people is that they enjoyed it, and so it will return again next year!





<u>GO! MAKE A DIFFERENCE:</u> We reach out to serve people in <u>ministry</u>, and seek to reach the lost with the Good News through <u>mission</u>. We do this through our serving teams, worship services, evangelism, outreach events, & with our Mission Partnerships.



GO! MAKE A DIFFERENCE: Ministry & Mission KNOW - GROW - GO! Looking Back, 2023-24



MISSION: Last year we:

- Held our annual community events: Kids' Christmas Party,
 Light Party and Easter "Eggstravaganza" led by the kids' team.
 Using a variety of activities, great relationships were built with
 children and parents, and the was Gospel clearly shared.
- Continued our bi-monthly Community Café: This warm and safe space, helps to connect with people who are isolated or lonely, over coffee, cake and a chat.
- Launched a monthly Care Home Outreach. Once a month, the team, led by Sandra, visited Gainsborough Hall to chat with the residents about life and faith, and to provide a listening ear. As a result we were invited to conduct a Carol Service there over Christmas (in addition to re-visiting Sebright House again!)
- Gave out 125 Christmas hampers to people in need of food and some love at Christmas, directly to the community and through local schools, Warwick District Foodbank and Helping Hands.
- Held our annual Carols By Candlelight outreach event, over 2 services. 183 people attended, with at least 58 from the local community, who do not usually attend our church services.

RE-VISION, 2023-24:

Some key highlights from last year's priorities:

PEOPLE:

- We celebrated the 10th Year Anniversary since Pastors Dave and Leanne were officially inducted as leaders of the church.
- We taught how to "Share your story" on Sunday mornings to equip people to live life missionally. We also ran a HABITS course through the Life Groups to start the journey to "BE disciples who MAKE disciples."
- We launched and ran phase one of our Leadership Development programme to identify, train and release vital leadership roles within the church across different levels.
- Ps. Dave & Leanne now have a wider role within the AoG, as Zone Leaders within the Central Area. They bring support & influence to about 33 churches and their pastors.
- Ps. Dave is also an AoG Coach to support and help develop Ministers in Training within the movement, to obtain their ministerial status.

• Ps. Dave & Leanne enjoyed a much appreciated three month Sabbatical, made possible due to the strengthening of teams and leaders within the house. During this time, more internal speakers were trained and released, we heard encouraging interviews from key people in the church, and we had many guest pastors come to share God's word. A year of variety of voice and sharing of the load!

PROPERTY:

- A small Property Development Team with professional experience, was identified and released to help us explore options for improving the site at Charlotte Street.
- A professional Market Valuation was conducted for the entire site (Church Centre and Manse) to understand a) the current rebuild costs for insurance purposes and b) an indication of the value of the site
- A Topographical Survey took place, which has given us site and building elevation drawings, useful for any future development.

RE-VISION, 2023-24: cont...



PLANTING:

- Ps. Leanne attended a Church Planting course at AoG's Missio Dei Bible College.
- We are having strategic, learning conversations with practitioners within AoG, apostolic mentors, as well as with the Church Planting Director, Ps. Misheck Manhanha.
- Ps. Dave & Leanne have been piloting a
 Missional Life Group, sharing Jesus
 with neighbours who aren't YET
 Christians.











INCOME AND ACCOUNTS

A comparison of 2022-23 vs 21-22 (Note: our latest completed financial year ran from Jul '22 to Jun '23)

- Total Income: increased from £121,138 to £135,957 (yr. 22-23) (+12%, Year on Year [YoY])
- Regular Tithes and Offerings: increased from £102,095 to £108,738 (yr. 22-23) (+6.5% YoY)
- Gift Aid reclaimed from HMRC: increased from £20,835 to £26,632 (+28% YoY).

THINGS TO CELEBRATE:

- We are in a good financial position.
- LCC has no debt, and 5 months reserves policy
- 10% of total income is given away to missions
- All salaries are set by independent trustees
- We have a small hardship fund which people can apply to if struggling financially.







THE SEASON AHEAD:

We thank the Lord for the journey so far. He has been so faithful to the church in the past and we are convinced that LCC's **best days are ahead!** We believe that the Lord is leading the church into a season of **breakthrough** - in and through our lives - to impact our community and take ground missionally. This season we are "building for breakthrough..."

In December, Ps. Misheck Manhanha brought a prophetic Word to LCC, about the church overcoming limitation, needed for us to advance and see breakthrough happen. God has called all of us individually and collectively to see his plans prevail through us. As we change our mindsets to believe "what God can do with a few...", imagine the impact we will make. Building for Breakthrough requires us to:

1. Develop our Discipleship:

Making disciples is on the heart of God. In fact it was Jesus' Great Commission to us all before he left the Earth. We are seeking to continue the journey of exploring what it really means to be "disciples who make disciples"...

2. Increase our Influence:

For the church to grow and expand, we need to continue the journey of Leadership Development within LCC, as we identify, train and release leaders in different areas. Ps. Dave & Leanne have also been asked in this season to serve AoG by connecting with Pastors and Leaders in our Zone (around 33 churches) to bring support and influence.

3. Progress our Property:

This year, we need to invest significant money to improve the existing building at LCC, in which there has been a Christian witness since 1900.

4. Mobilise into Mission:

The leadership team believes that now is the time to take the **church planting dream forward** by training and equipping a core launch team for our first church plant. The Lord has been impressing upon us 4 different locations over time, with a strong burden for West Coventry initially, as well as possibly 3 other areas (including where LCC currently is – *please see the map*). This is also the year, for the church to "leave the building" as we offer "Prayer on the Streets" to those who need it. Come and be part of the adventure!

VISION PRIORITIES & OFFERING, 2023

In addition to our regular tithes and offerings, this year's Vision Offering will be used to advance LCC's mission of:

"Helping people grow in a relationship with Jesus Christ"

As we enter the season of "building for breakthrough" we will progress the journey to:

- Develop our Discipleship
- Increase our Influence
- Progress our Property
- Mobilise into Mission

Specifically, we will seek to further our Vision Priorities in the following ways*:

1. PRESENT Ministries (approx. 25%):

To support the core budget to strengthen existing ministries and mission, and to cover overheads.

2. PEOPLE (approx. 10%):

To develop our discipleship in Life Groups and practical workshops, and to train and release more leaders to increase our influence.

3. PROPERTY (approx. 55%):

To add to existing building fund to **progress the property** by:

- Purchasing wireless equipment for the worship team, to tidy the stage area.
- Relocating the sound and media desk to a new dedicated space, increasing seating capacity, and improving storage facilities.
- Investigating and repairing the party (retaining)
 wall by the Manse, and improving the
 aesthetics of the Manse garden.

4. PLANTING (approx. 10%):

To mobilise into mission by:

- training and equipping a core launch team, and set aside money for resources & buildings.
- Training a team of people to reach out to people using "Prayer on the Streets".

*Exact amounts and proportions may vary depending on the total given/pledged and as needs unfold. These are our current thoughts.


God amazingly led us to LCC and in January 2023, we became part of LCC, a warm and welcoming church deeply rooted in the word of God.
